

Hello everyone,

After a long absence, the opportunity for a return to the world of records was offered to me thanks to the purchase I just made of a collection of 78 rpm opera and classical music interesting which belonged to one of my friends, now gone. Georges Antreiber, it's his name, was an extremely passionate collector and knew very well all the great European and American singers. His culture in this area was very vast. I held and promised his widow to mention it here.

I thank very warmly all my old customers to whom I asked to send me their E-mail. Because, indeed, they all answered me and sent messages very enthusiastic, but also very friendly and expressed to me their joy to see me reappearing. It moved me a lot and encouraged me to redo lists as seriously and passionately as before. I hope to gain the confidence and sympathy of some others whose address I have been able to find, but who do not know me yet. I will do everything to not disappoint them, but on the contrary to satisfy them.

So that my list is a success and that I can continue to make others, I ask all those who know collectors, to have the kindness to communicate it to them, or to speak to them about me and to give them my E-mail. Among my old customers, many are unfortunately no longer there, or no longer collect. So it is necessary for me to know other fans of 78 rpm records.

In this new list, I only put disks in perfect condition, graduated 1, or have only very slight problems and not audible, graduated 2. As I stopped all activity in the disks for 10 years , it is likely that there are inconsistencies in my MB (minimum bid), especially for Russian, German and Italian records ... The end of my list consists only of photos of disc labels (front / back)), because I thought it's attractive for everyone to view the discs. I only noted the catalog number, the MB and some information concerning in particular the French singers that I know well. I remind collectors who bought me, the booklet in which there are 105 biographies of French singers that I made about 10 years ago and who can provide them with useful information.

Regarding the payment of the disks, I have a PayPal account. You can also send me a bank check or an international money order. The shipping costs of the discs will be the responsibility of each one.


